DEVELOPING ORGANISATIONS

We need 3 members to take over the guidance and support of the developing organizations on their way towards the fulfilment of the stability criteria.

- Ensure quality and effective communication with the organization
- Have online calls with those organizations
- Ensure the proper handover with the respective Regional Coordinator
- Report to the NCC

ACTIVE EXPANSION

We would like to introduce our member's active in the field of Human Resources, network care and management to the field of policy and advocacy, and to show them how relevant it is for these two fields to interact for the sake of the development of our organisation.

The main task of the members interested to work on active expansion would be to create two Toolkits:

1. A Toolkit for universities to inform the staff on the core activity of ESN, our services, how our sections support the universities, and similar;
2. A Toolkit to train local students and Erasmus+ alumni who are interested to establish new local ESN sections.
